

Tuesday, May 29

1:00-3:00 pm – Registration in Centennial Towers West Lobby. When you arrive - Leave your instruments at the instrument trailers in the parking lot. Make sure your name is on the outside of your case.

1. Register at the UNK Housing Registration table first to receive your room assignments, lanyards, keys and dining hall tags.
2. Then register at the Masonic Band Registration in the lounge. Band shirts, visors, ID badges and other registration materials will be distributed here.
3. Take your things up to your room. If you will be leaving a car in the lot, make sure you have everything out of it that you need and return to the CTW Lobby to receive a parking permit. Place the permit in your car, and return to the lobby to turn in your keys. Your keys will be returned Saturday morning during check out.
4. Try on your shirt before Orientation. If the fit of the shirt is bad, we can try to exchange sizes for you during registration after everyone has received them.

A music supply company (**cgs Music**) will have a table set up from 1:00 to 3:00 pm if you need to purchase flip folders, additional pages, lyres, etc.

3:30 pm – Orientation in Cushing Coliseum. You will need your music stands, flip folders, pencils and supplies for practice. Find a place to sit in Cushing Coliseum. You must wear your ID badges.

4:00-5:15 pm – Indoor Practice at Cushing Coliseum. You will be instructed to get your instruments following orientation.

5:15 pm – Assemble in squads to go to Dining Hall. (Leave instruments at seats in Cushing Coliseum)

5:30-6:30 pm – Dinner – You must wear your ID badge and dining hall tag for access to the dining hall at all times.

6:30 pm – Assemble in squads to go to Foster Field.

6:45-10:00 pm – Combo Outside Practice at Foster Field and **Indoor Practice** at Cushing Coliseum.

10:00 pm – Return Instruments to the trailers. Place instruments in cases, **close your cases** and hand them to a member of the truck team or follow instructions for returning instruments to the trailers.

If you want pizza or other delivery tonight, order it during a break at practice, must be delivered at dorms no later than 10:15 pm. (Centennial Towers West south doors)

10:30 pm – Floor Meeting in floor lounge

11:00 pm – Lights out and room check

Wednesday, May 30

7:00-8:00 am – Breakfast in Dining Hall. You must have your ID badge and dining hall tag.

8:00 am – Put on your band shirt and assemble in squads to go to Foster Field. **Bring your music and drill charts!** You will need to bring another shirt to change into after the group picture. Don't forget water bottles, comfortable shoes, caps and sunscreen.

8:15 am – Group picture

8:45-11:15 am – Marching Practice at Foster Field

11:30 am-12:30 pm – Lunch in Dining Hall

12:45 pm – Get your instruments and Assemble in squads before going to Foster Field

1:00-3:00 pm – Marching Practice at Foster Field

3:00 pm – Carry your instruments to Cushing Coliseum for Indoor Practice

3:15-5:15 pm – Indoor Practice at Cushing Coliseum

5:15-6:15 pm – Dinner in Dining Hall (leave instruments at Cushing Coliseum)

6:00 pm – Sign up your bowling teams by this time. Lists are on the wall in CTW Lobby.

6:15 pm – Assemble in squads to go to Cushing Coliseum

6:30-7:30 pm – Parade Marching Practice, start at Cushing Coliseum

7:30 pm – Return to dorms and instruments to trailers and get items needed for the evening.

7:45 pm – Assemble in squads to go to Foster Field

8:00-10:00 pm – Music on the Green at Foster Field. At this activity, you will be watching bands and enjoying some free time. Bring a blanket, pillow, etc. if you would like. There will be no early returns. Pizza can be ordered, but it will not be allowed on the field and must be eaten under the bleachers.

If you want pizza, order for delivery by 9:00 pm at the Foster Field northwest fence entrance only. No orders or delivery at the dorms later.

10:00 pm – Assemble in squads to return to the dorms

10:45 pm – Lights out and room check

7:00-7:45 am – Breakfast in Dining Hall

7:45 am – Get your instruments and Assemble in squads to go to Foster Field

8:00-11:15 am – Marching Practice at Foster Field

11:15 am – Return instruments to trailers before going to lunch

11:30 am-12:30 pm – Lunch in Dining Hall

12:30 pm – Get your instruments and Assemble in squads before practice at Cushing Coliseum

12:45-2:15 pm – Indoor Practice at Cushing Coliseum, this may include **Parade Marching** from 1:15-2:15

2:15 pm – Carry your instruments to Foster Field for Marching Practice

2:30-5:30 pm – Marching Practice at Foster Field

5:30 pm – Return instruments to trailers before going to dinner

5:45-6:30 pm – Dinner in Dining Hall; Get ready for the dance. Dress for the dance is casual.

7:45 pm – Assemble in squads to go to the dance at the Student Union Ponderosa Room

8:00-10:30 pm – Dance at Union Ponderosa Room. There will be no early returns from the dance.

If you want pizza, order at the dance, delivery by 10:15 pm at the northwest lower level entrance to the Union across from the dorm). No delivery at the dorms.

10:30 pm – Assemble in squads to return to dorms

7:30-8:30 am – Breakfast in Dining Hall

8:30 am – Get your instruments and Assemble in squads to go to Foster Field

8:45-11:15 am – Marching Practice at Foster Field

11:15 am – Return instruments to trailers before lunch

11:30-12:30 pm – Lunch in Dining Hall

12:30 pm – Get your instruments and Assemble in squads to go to Cushing Coliseum

12:45-2:30 pm – Indoor Practice at Cushing Coliseum. **Bring your uniform shirt** with you for News Release pictures (*no black shorts or visors*) You can just put the shirt over the shirt you're wearing. **Bring the picture assignment sheets with you that you received when squading up.**

2:30-4:00 pm – News Release Pictures in Cushing Coliseum. Band Assistant interviews and thank you letter writing will also be done at this time.

4:00 pm – Return instruments to trailers and get ready for concert

Get dressed in your blue uniform shirts, black shorts and white shoes (no visors). Bring a shirt to change into for the bowling alley.

4:45 pm – Get your instruments and Assemble in squads to get ready to go to Harmon Park

5:00 pm – Line up and parade march to Harmon Park (8 blocks)

5:30 pm – Concert at Harmon Park

After Concert – Return instruments to trailers, Sack suppers will be provided

7:00 pm - Load buses and take attendance to go to Big Apple Fun Center. **Your bus number is on the back of your name badge.**

We will have 3 buses – Bus numbers 1-3 will load and go first to the bowling alley. Bus numbers 4-6 will wait and go when the buses return.

7:15 pm – Check in at Big Apple Fun Center

7:30-9:30 pm – Bowling at Big Apple Fun Center

No pizza orders tonight. Get food at the bowling alley.

9:30 pm – Load buses and take attendance to return to dorms. **Buses 4-6 load first**

10:15 pm – Floor meetings. You will receive **check-out packets** at the floor meetings

10:45 pm – Lights out and room check

Saturday, June 2

7:00-8:00 am –

1. **Eat Breakfast** in Dining Hall
2. **Dress for the parade** in band uniform (band shirt, black shorts, white socks, white shoes, visor and ID badge-tuck badges into your shirts during performances).

8:55 am – Load buses and take attendance **Buses 4-6 load first**

9:10 am – Buses leave for parade route

9:15 am – Get your instruments and Walk to parade route at Central Ave & Railroad Street to Stage for parade

10:00 am – Parade starts

11:00 am – Load buses and take attendance to return to UNK for lunch **Buses 1-3 load first**

11:30-12:30 pm – Lunch in the Dining Hall and Check out of dorm rooms in CTW Lobby. Do this as early as possible.

Steps to Check Out:

- Make sure you have everything out of your room (check drawers, bathroom, under beds, etc.) **Take your plastic bag of garbage with you and put it in a trash can in the lobby or in the commons area of your floor.**
- Have your parents or guardians pick up your luggage **before 12:30 pm. Storage space WILL NOT be available during the game.**
- Follow instructions from UNK residence staff in lobby to check out – either turning in keys and meal cards to personnel or placing keys and meal cards in a box on the counter in the lobby.

1:00 pm – Get your instruments and Assemble in squads to go to Foster Field.

1:15 pm – Setup in stands in North End Zone.

1:40 pm – Line up before kick-off. You will perform the pre-game National Anthem, at halftime, as well as pep songs during the first half of the game.

2:00 pm – National Anthem and Game Kick-off

Halftime – Band Performance

After Halftime – All students are free to leave with their parents or guardians after the half-time performance, and do not need to check out.

Just a few reminders:

- ❖ Wear **your own** lanyard and ID badge at all times. Do not lose, chew on or otherwise destroy them.
- ❖ Get to your assigned locations early.
- ❖ Girls are not allowed on the boys' floors or in boys' rooms and boys are not allowed on the girls' floors or in girls' rooms.
- ❖ Band Students may not leave campus without permission from Michelle Fulmer, Camp Coordinator or Roger Dill, Band Committee Chairman. Your parent or guardian will need to sign you out.
- ❖ Don't lose your room key. (\$55 each)
- ❖ Don't change rooms. If there is a problem, please talk to a chaperone as soon as possible.
- ❖ Take good care of the residence halls. UNK will charge you for any damages to rooms. If you notice any problems with your room upon check-in, report it immediately to the front desk or a chaperone. Also, if you have problems with plumbing in the bathrooms, report it immediately.
- ❖ Keep the windows in your room closed.
- ❖ Don't hang out in the stairwells or elevator.
- ❖ You are representing your school and your Masonic sponsor. Please conduct yourself accordingly.
- ❖ Inappropriate touching of other students or staff will not be tolerated. Inappropriate touching is any physical contact that violates the touched person's comfort level. No lewd touching or other improper contact of a sexual nature will be permitted.
- ❖ If anything happens that makes you uncomfortable, no matter what or who it is, please let someone know immediately so that it can be addressed.
- ❖ Vulgar, obscene, suggestive or profane language or behavior is strictly forbidden.
- ❖ Use of tobacco products, alcohol, or controlled substances will not be tolerated and will be cause for immediate dismissal.
- ❖ Don't walk on campus alone – always stay in groups.
- ❖ Band uniforms are to be worn only for pictures on Wednesday and Friday, the concert on Friday, and the parade and game on Saturday.
- ❖ If you feel overheated or ill for any reason, please leave the practice room or exit the field and alert a chaperone as soon as possible.
- ❖ **If you have any problems**, please don't be afraid to talk to Michelle Fulmer, Roger Dill, or another chaperone.
