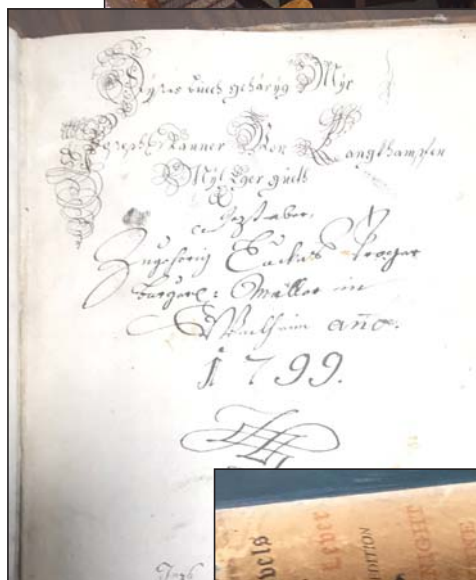

The Nebraska Masonic Museum & Research Library was re-dedicated Saturday, September 5, 2015.

Established as a separate entity from the Grand Lodge A.:F.: & A.:M.: of Nebraska, the Museum & Research Library are managed by the Masonic Heritage Committee of the Nebraska Masonic Foundation (established 1985). This arrangement allows for long-term stability in the planning, organizing, directing, and financial management of the Museum & Research Library.



"The Friends of the Library" provides resources ensuring the Masonic community and the general public know that the Nebraska Masonic Museum & Research Library is open to everyone. Donations for restoration, purchases, et al., can be made through the Nebraska Masonic Foundation, an established 501(c)(3) organization under the codes and regulations of the U.S. Internal Revenue Service.

The purpose of the Nebraska Masonic Museum & Research Library is to educate, preserve, display and make available the art, relics and library material owned by the Foundation and managed by the Masonic Heritage Committee.
